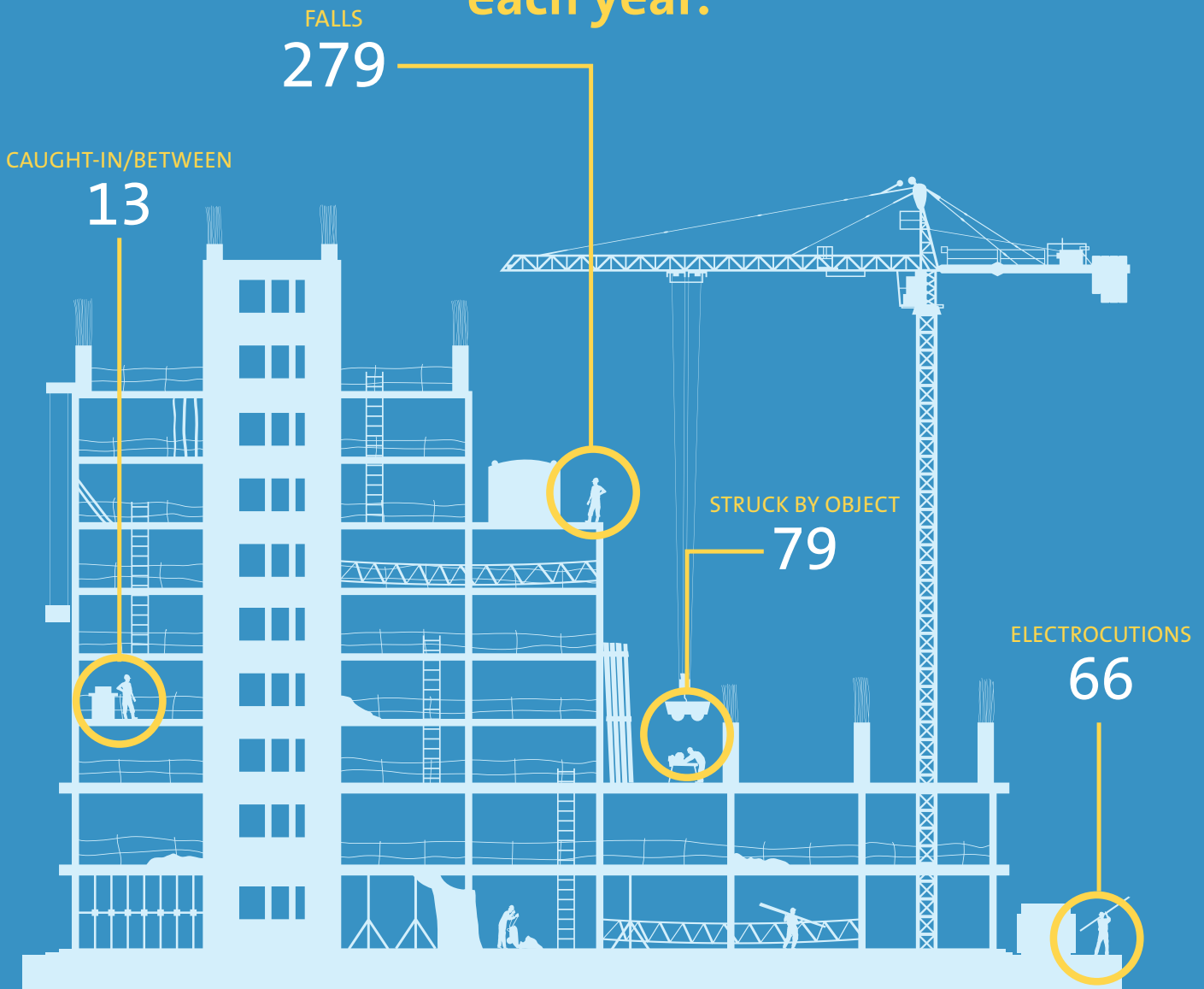


Construction's "Fatal Four" are responsible for 54% of construction workers' deaths each year.
